




# **OVERVIEW**

### **Participants must:**


- Be a current club executive in the football industry.

### **WHERE**


Due to international travel restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the programme will consist of a combination of online and on-site modules (subject to developments in the pandemic).



### **WHEN**


The programme will run from March 2021 to January 2022.




### **APPLICATION PROCESS**
