## Women's football: Coach Mentorship

Dear Sir or Madam,

Supporting our member associations to achieve their objectives for women's football remains a top priority for FIFA. Following the launch of the FIFA Women's Development Programme in September 2020 (see FIFA circular no. 1730), we are pleased to announce that we are now opening the application process for the **Coach Mentorship** programme.

With this initiative, which is the seventh programme to be rolled out as part of the FIFA Women's Development Programme, our goal is to help more female coaches occupy and retain positions at the highest level. Each coach will be assigned to an experienced coach (mentor), who will guide and support the mentee throughout the programme.

With the implementation of this programme, we aim to meet the following objectives:

- Increase the number of qualified female coaches working in the game
- Give existing talents additional leadership to help them achieve greater results in their current coaching positions and secure future success
- Support female coaches by providing guidance on career development and a platform for networking

To be eligible for the Coach Mentorship programme, each successful applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a female qualified coach "A" or "Pro" licence holder and/or a national team coach in an active coaching role
- Submit the specific Coach Mentorship application form (enclosed), accompanied by:
  - o maximum two-minute video explaining why they wish to be a part of the programme
  - o recommendation letter from the association's general secretary, undertaking to support the mentee during and after the programme as well as to offer logistical support (visit of the mentor and/or expenses of mentee when abroad)



The applicants will also be expected to attend the following:

- Online onboarding sessions with the FIFA Women's Football Division and other participants
- Online Coach Mentorship workshops with mentors and mentees
- · Regular online meetings between the mentee and the mentor
- Two possible on-site visits (depending on COVID-19 and travel restrictions)

All applicants need to submit the enclosed application form, together with documents confirming that they meet the above-mentioned criteria, to <u>developmentprogramme@fifa.org</u> before the closing date of the application process on 30 November 2021.
